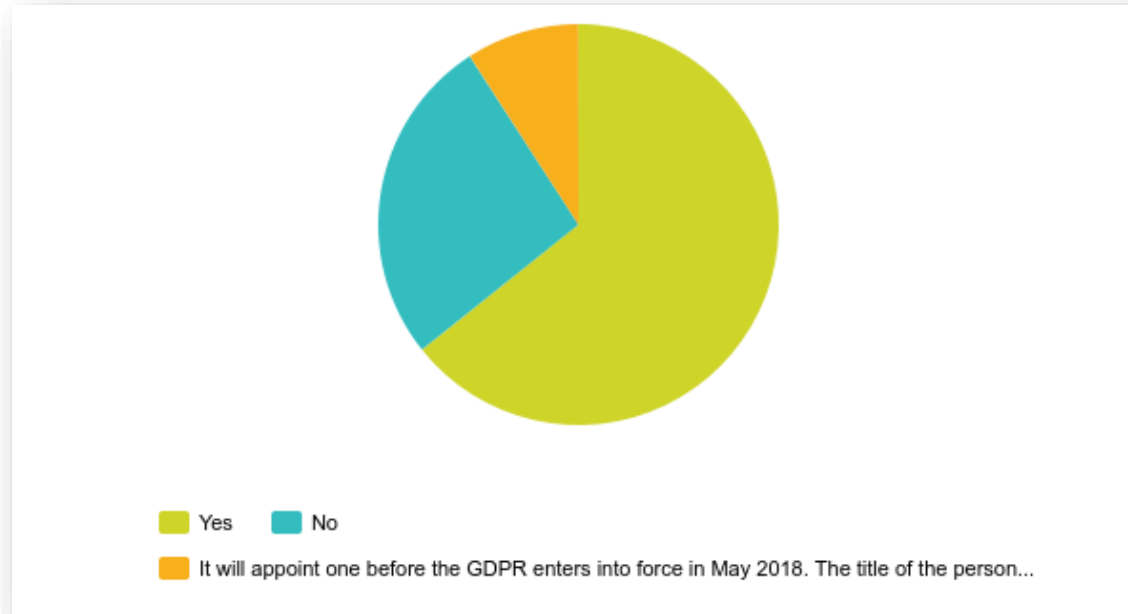

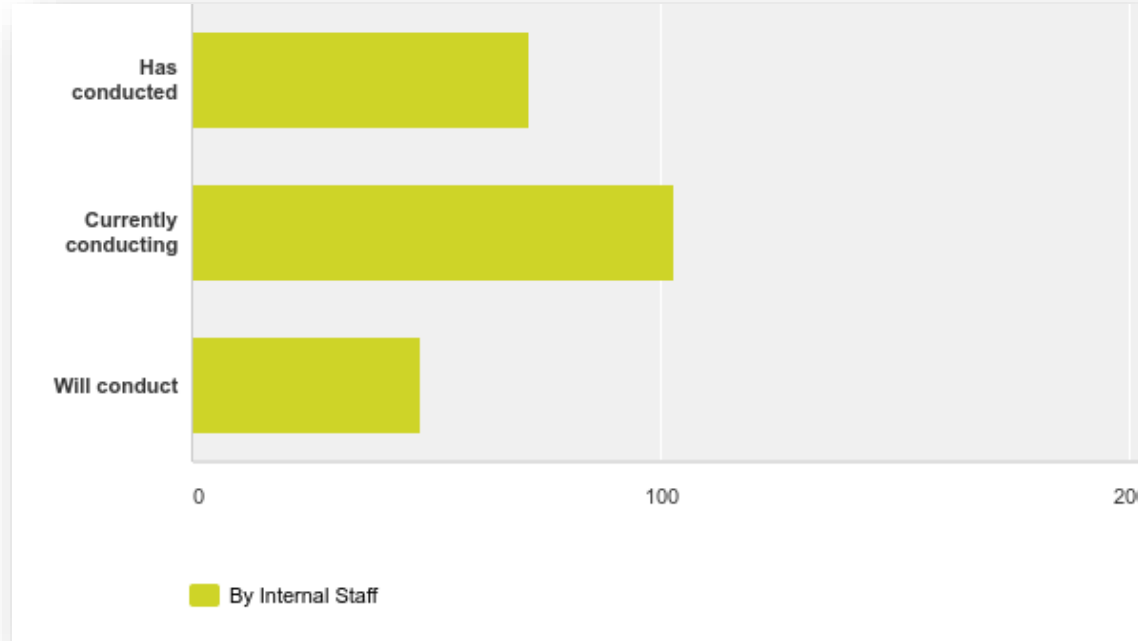
# Q1: Does your organisation already have an employee with the title of Data Protection Officer or similar?

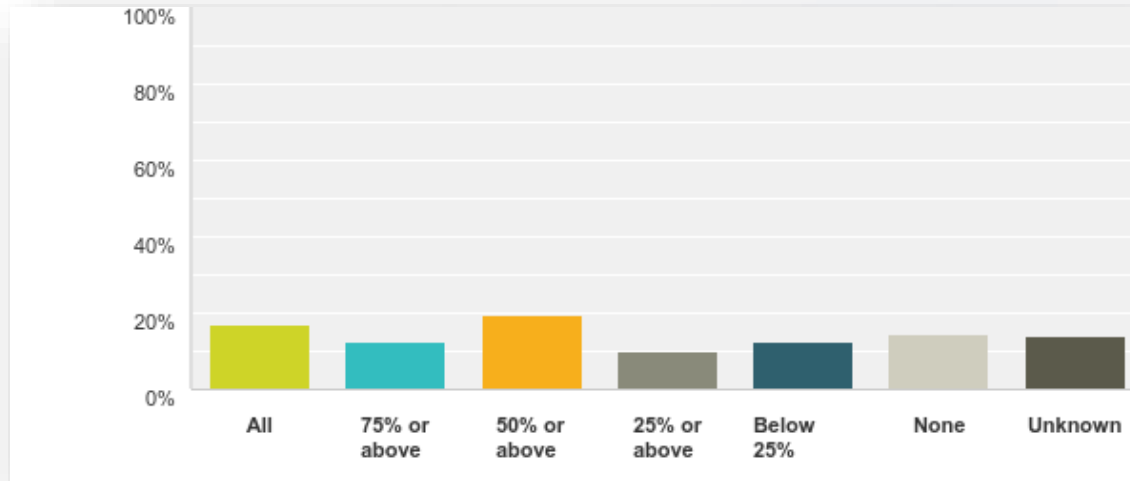
## Q2: Is your organisation currently conducting/ or have you conducted an audit for the purposes of the GDPR to establish what personal data you have?

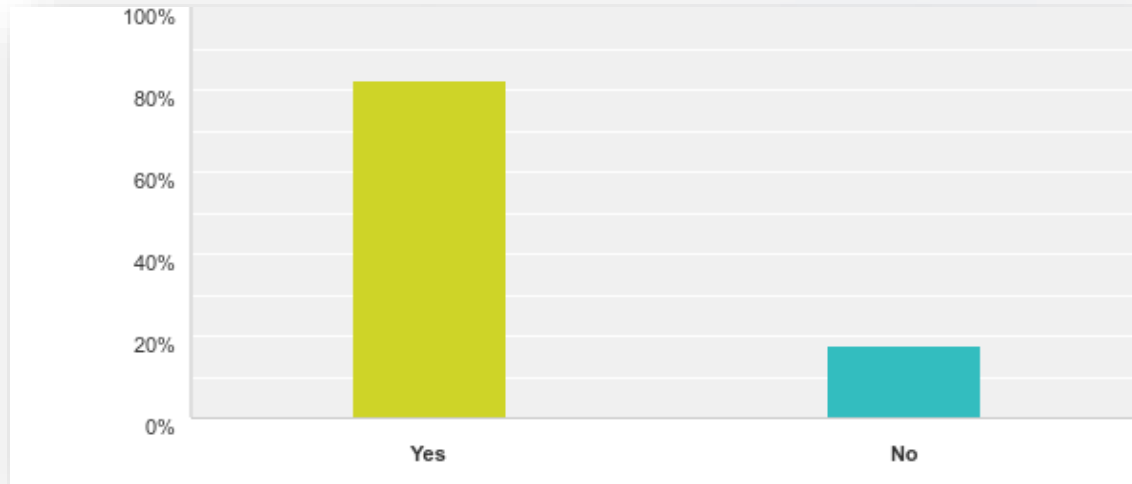
### Q3: What proportion of your data protection policies have been reviewed to ensure they comply with the new GDPR provisions?

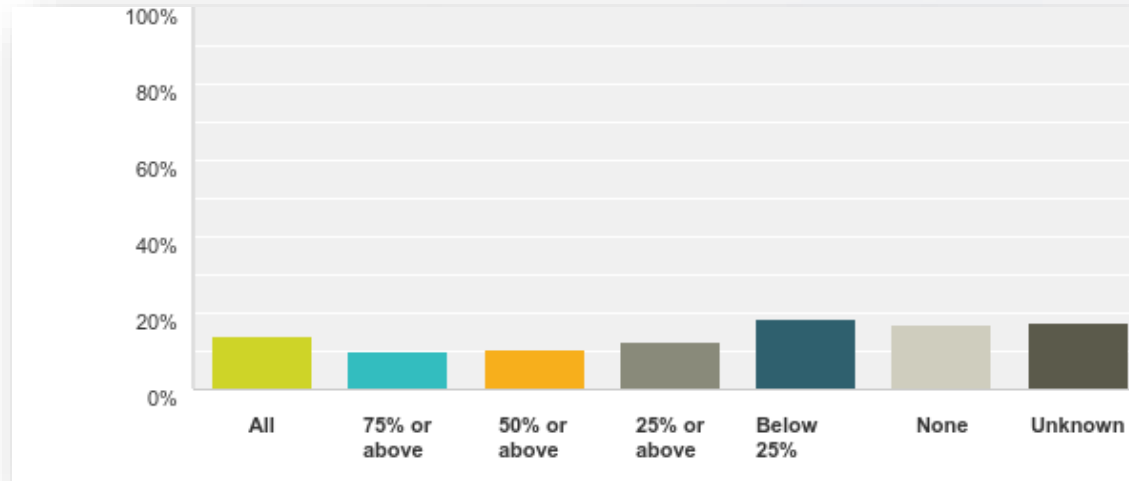
## Q4: Has your organisation established the purposes for which you process personal data?

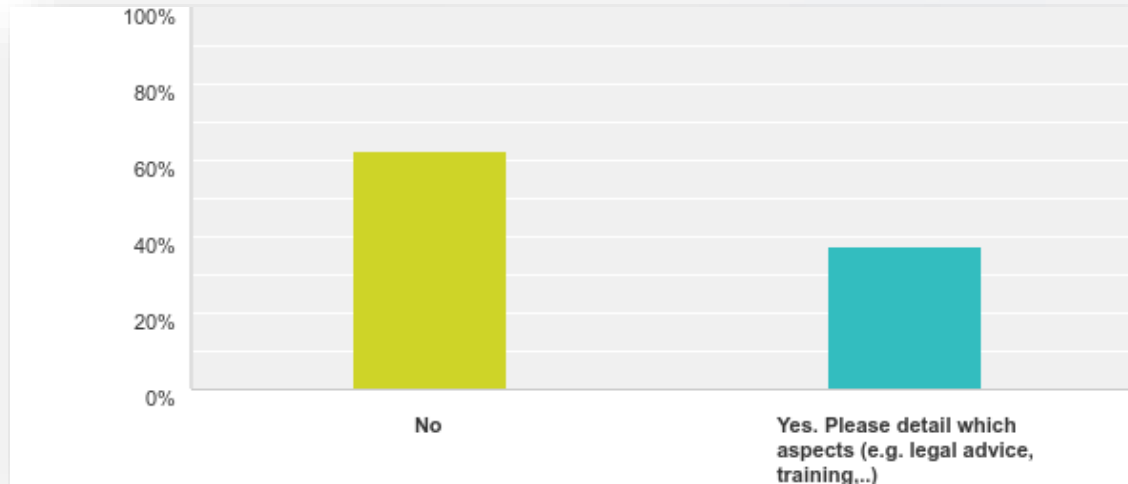
## Q5: What proportion of supplier contracts have been reviewed from the data protection perspective?

## Q6: Has your organisation used external legal advice for GDPR preparations?

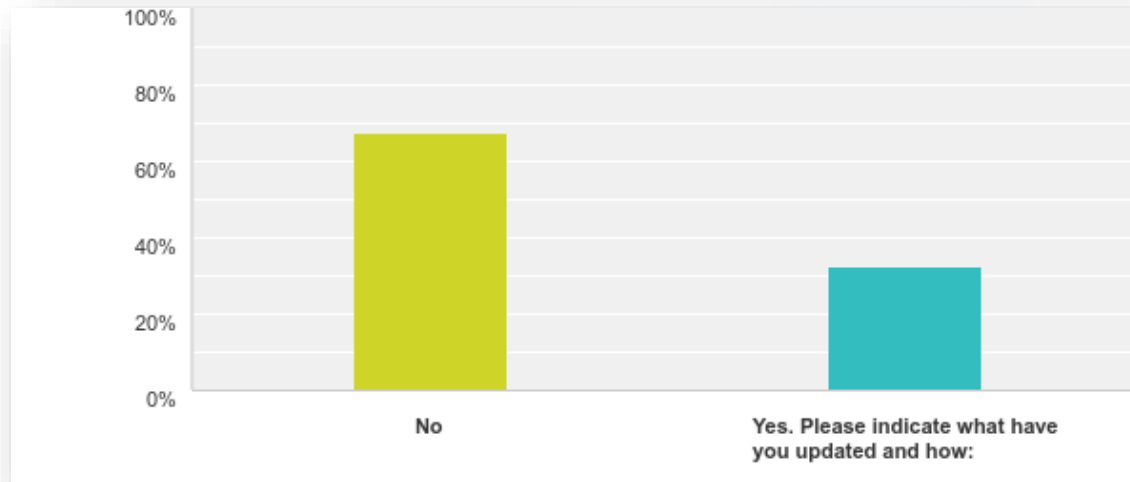

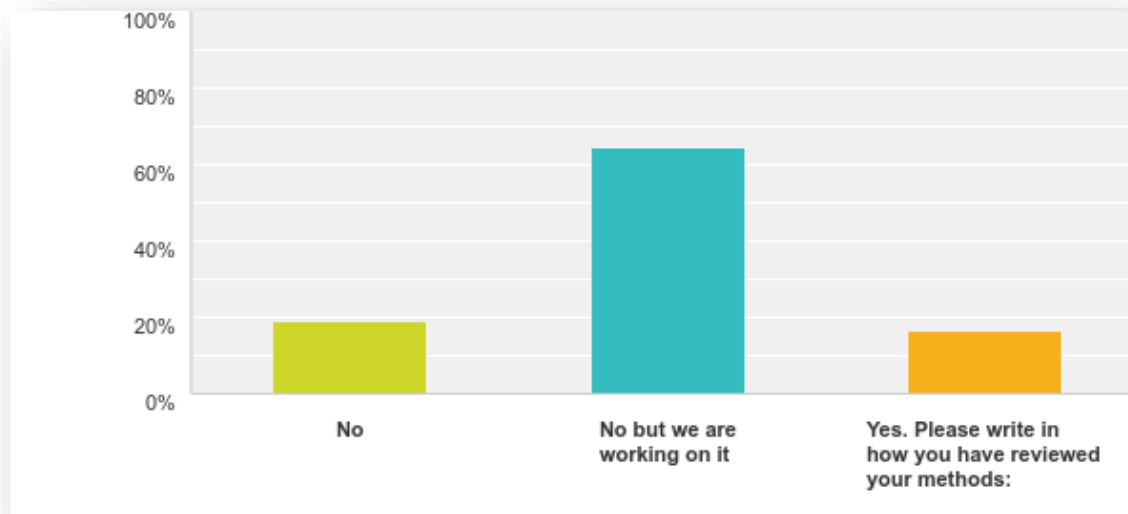

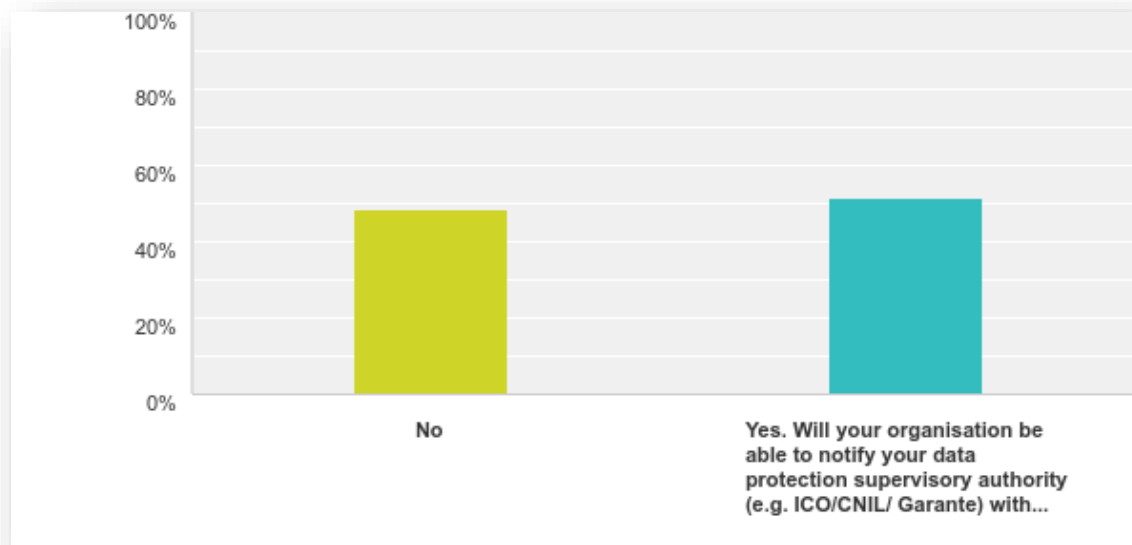
